1. Describe the cycle of carbon through ecosystems. Carbon-based organic molecules are essential to all organisms. Photosynthetic organisms convert CO₂ to organic molecules through photosynthesis that are consumed by heterotrophs. Carbon reservoirs include fossil fuels, soils and sediments, solutes in oceans, plant and animal biomass, the atmosphere, and sedimentary rocks.
